OVERVIEW

The Tegan and Sara Foundation (TSF) fights for health, economic justice and representation for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGBTQ) girls and women. This mission is founded on a commitment to feminism and racial, social and gender justice. TSF funds programs centered on research, public education and support services to build long-term well-being and advocacy for the LGBTQ community.

In 2018, TSF's Queer Health Access initiative will improve the quality and quantity of healthcare-related research serving the LGBTQ community by sponsoring a Queer Health Hackathon. Hosted at the Broad Institute of MIT and Harvard in Cambridge, MA from September 21-23, the hackathon will focus on creative and collaborative problem-solving with medical, scientific and technical experts. The three-day event will bring together experts from medical, technical and policy disciplines to better understand health disparities in the LGBTQ community with innovative analysis of healthcare experiences through a data science lens. In addition, hackers will be granted exclusive access to de-identified patient data from a premiere healthcare organization.

Attendee Challenge:

Show statistically significant disparities in disease occurence or healthcare outcomes for the LGBTQ population based on access to anonymized patient health data.
